Richland County is awarding \$1,000 scholarships to area high school seniors attending a post-secondary institution.

Scholarship applicants must:

1. Have parents who have maintained Richland County Farm Bureau membership for the current year and at least two years before.
2. Any field of study is acceptable; preference will be given to an agricultural field of study.
3. Scholarship award based on merit. Achievements in school and community as well as future plans are deciding factors.
4. 2.5 or higher grade point average must be maintained.
5. Applicants will not be judged on basis of race, color, creed, religion, or gender.
6. Decisions of the judging panel are final.
7. Deadline for applications is July 31st.
